New Clause 1(A) inserted in the Memorandum of Association by Resolution passed on 31st December 2004.

1(A)(a) To carry on the business of an investment company, and for that purpose to acquire and hold either in the name of the company or in that of any nominee shares, stocks, debentures, debenture stock, bonds, notes, obligations, warrants, options and securities issued or guaranteed by any company wherever incorporated, or issued or guaranteed by any government, public body or authority in any part of the world.

1(A)(b) To acquire any such shares, stock, debentures, debenture stock, bonds, notes, obligations, warrants, options or securities by subscription, purchase, exchange, underwriting or otherwise, and whether or not fully paid up, and subject to such terms and conditions (if any) as may be thought fit.

1(A)(c) To exercise and enforce all rights and powers conferred by or incident to the ownership of any investment of the company, and to provide managerial, administrative, supervisory and consultant services for or in relation to any company in which the company is interested on such terms as may be thought fit.
