**MEMBERSHIP**

As at the 31st October 1990 there were 331 Members of the Society. The death during the year of Mr. J. Elliott is recorded with great regret.

## **METINGS**

An important year for this Society with Mr. Anthony Hollard, a past President of the Society, having been elected the National President which is perhaps no more than just reward for his hard work on behalf of solicitors in general and on behalf of this Society in particular and which brings great credit to this Society.

The Committee has continued to meet regularly each month throughout the year and once again the year has to an extent been dominated by the Courts and Legal Services Bill, plus, of course, the introduction of the Conveyancing Protocol. A special meeting was held to discuss the Courts and Legal Services Bill in particular in relation to the proposed changes in the education and training of solicitors and to the Practice Rules. The general view of those attending that meeting was in favour of the changes proposed, although concern was expressed by some country practices in connection with the proposed amendment to Rule 6 to remove the exemption for solicitors being allowed to act for both parties. The meeting in connection with Conveyancing Protocol was arranged in order to obtain the views of members of the Society on the Conveyancing Protocol once it had been in operation for a period. Again, the general view of those attending was in favour of the Protocol although various specific points were raised by members and all comments raised have been passed on to Chancery Lane. It is hoped that the majority of firms in this area will be converted to the use of the Protocol. The attendances at these meetings continues to be disappointing.

Our links with the L'Ordre Des Avocats au Barreau de Bruxelles have continued and two French lawyers attended our Annual Dinner and a number of members of the Society are visiting them in the near future.

Lectures have continued to be held in conjunction with the Polytechnic South West but it has to be reported that attendances have unfortunately been poor, and indeed the last lecture had to be cancelled because of lack of support. Efforts are being made with Polytechnic South West to ensure any future lectures are on topics that are of interest to local practising solicitors and it is hoped that this will result in better attendances in future.

## PUBLIC RELATIONS AND SERVICE

The Accident Claims Scheme continues in operation and is regularly and quite widely used by members of the public and appears to run very satisfactorily. The Advice Services at the Citizens Advice Bureau have also continued although perhaps not as fully utilised as in the past.

## SOCIAL

Two main social events took place this year, the Annual Dinner and Dinner/Dance on behalf of the Solicitors' Benevolent Association. In both cases the attendance figures were somewhat down from previous years but nonetheless it was possible to make a donation of £500 to the Solicitors' Benevolent Association.

## GENERAL

The profession continues to face very many fundamental changes in the way it operates but it is to be hoped that all those changes will prove to be to the benefit of the profession in the long run, although that may not always appear to be the case. The Committee has continued to make representations to Chancery Lane reflecting the views expressed by members of the Society.
