Passed on the 25th day of Moresbur 1990

At an Annual General Meeting of the above-named Company, duly convened and held at the Duke of Cornwall, Millbay Road, Plymouth, Devon on the 26th day of November 1990 the following resolution was duly passed:

- 1. Article 29 be renumbered 29(A).
- 2. Insert a new Article 29(B) as follows: ~

In this Article "Kingsbridge Number" shall mean a Number of the Society who at the time of his election practises and has his chambers or offices in Kingsbridge, Salcombe or Medbury and "Tavistock Nember" shall mean a Number of the Society who at the time of his election practises and has his chambers or offices in Tavistock or Taybridge.

If the captidates nominated (otherwise them as officers) are more thin twelve in number, the Kingsbridge Number with the most votes and the Tavistock Number with the most votes shall be elected to the Committee and the other ten candidates with the most votes shall be elected to the Committee.
