MEMBERSHIP

As at the 30th September 1988 there were 281 Members of the Society including those Members who have retired from practice but remain as Honorary Members. The death during the year of Mr. D. Mills is recorded with regret.

MEETINGS

The Committee has continued to meet monthly with sub-committees meeting as required. As was mentioned last year the requests for comments on matters of vital importance to the profession are all too frequently made with almost impossibly short time limits although there are signs that this is being recognised on high and longer periods are now more often given.

Topics dealt with during the year have included the Paper on Access to Civil Justice where the Committee came down on the side of contingency fee arrangements being permitted. Panels for the monitoring of articles have been re-appointed. Comments were submitted on the Paper on Deposits in Conveyancing Transactions.

Lectures on courses on various legal topics have been instituted in conjunction with Plymouth Polytechnic and these have been well received apart from producing a welcome profit for the Society.

Meetings have been held with the local Court administrators to discuss various matters.

Some members enjoyed, and were enlightened by, a tour of H.M. Land Registry in Plymouth.

A meeting was arranged with members of the Solicitors European Group. It is disappointing again to report a poor attendance particularly for speakers who had travelled some way. Those who did attend however found the meeting instructive and useful.

PUBLIC RELATIONS AND SERVICE

The advice sessions of the Citizens Advice Bureau have continued weekly.
The venture of a Plymouth Sound Advice Centre set up in conjunction with
the local radio station Plymouth Sound although well adverted on the radio,
has had a surprisingly disappointing response, but may well pick up.

The Accident Claims scheme continues and remains a mainly local exercise.

SOCIAL

The Annual Dinner in October 1988 was again the Society's main official
social event and again was very popular. A revised method of ticket allocation
seems to have enabled all members wishing to attend to do so.

There was however another social event - a dinner dance in aid of the
Solicitors Benevolent Association which was also very popular and enjoyable.
This had the additional advantage of raising over £2,200.00 for the
Association who were very grateful.

Members of the Committee also joined in a reception for members of the
Law Society's Law Committee who were meeting in Plymouth and took the
opportunity to express local feelings.

GENERAL

Last year's report referred to profound changes within the profession. It
welcomed the new Lord Chancellor if, as then supposed, he was a lawyer
rather than a politician. Members must judge whether the pronouncements
since made are those of a lawyer keen to improve his profession or those of an
administrator bowing to the pressures of government and pressure groups. It
does seem in the light of recent pronouncements that no area of the legal
profession is closed to those who, with limited qualifications, can offer cheaper
if limited service. In this light the suggestion of multi disciplinary practices
takes on a whole new meaning. The profession has grown accustomed over the
years to being attacked from time to time by the media, by authors and by
pressure groups. It is a fairly novel experience but one to which the profession
will obviously have to become accustomed, to be attacked by its own
hierarchy.

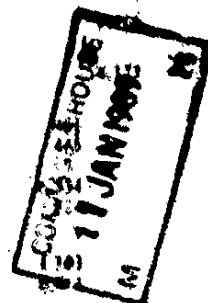
