THE SOCIETY'S ADMINISTRATION

Your Committee has continued to meet on a regular basis throughout the past year and has dealt with a substantial amount of business. The informal meetings with District Judge Slim at Halifax County Court and the County Court Users Committee have continued to prove useful in affording two way communication and regular reports of these are given to the Committee. The Committee has also provided representatives to the local Legal Services Commission advisory group. The Committee has continued to support the seminars run with Huddersfield University and has continued to develop and co-ordinate courses with the Regional Secretary of the Law Society, lan Croft. Any suggestions as to course subjects should be passed to any member of the Committee. The Committee still believe that the provision of cost effective and cost conscious, relevant training is of the utmost importance.

Yorkshire Regional Meetings have been attended by your President and Senior Vice President throughout the year who have reported back to the Committee. It is hoped that the Yorkshire Region will provide a more effective way of establishing a realistic local complaints procedure in future.

The local complaints procedure set up over a year ago has dealt with few complaints and these have been referred back to the firms concerned. They have mainly arisen from poor communication, costs information and an apparent overloading of work. It is hoped that a more formal structure via the Region may assist.
