# REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE for the year 1995

Your Committee has pleasure in presenting its ONE HUNDRED AND TENTH ANNUAL REPORT.

There have been ten meetings of the Committee during this year. Three before the Annual General Meeting and seven after.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

The membership of the Society is now 121 of whom 95 are members of the Solicitors' Benevolent Association. A welcome is extended to the new members this year: MARION BATTEN, HEATHER EGGLETON, MARGARET ANNE GLYNN, NORMA JANE RUDLAND, PHILIPPA SELBY, JONATHAN DUDLEY ELLIS SHAWE, MOHAMMED ALI SIDDIQUE, CAROLINE ANNE STEVENSON, DELIA HELEN CROFTS-TURNBULL, IAN WOOD and NICHOLAS WORSNOP.

#### THE SOCIETY'S ADMINISTRATION

Your Committee continued to meet on a regular basis throughout the past year and has dealt with a substantial amount of business.

In an effort to improve the service from Halifax County Court your Secretary and Education Officer attended a meeting with Mr. Delaney, Courts Administrator of the Lord Chancellor's Department. An outline of the main complaints was made to Mr. Delaney who assured your Representatives that there had already been some improvements in the service provided and that other complaints would be addressed.

The Committee has proceeded to investigate the possible creation of a training organisation, providing continuing education courses to suit members' needs. A feasibility report is in the course of preparation.

Your President and Secretary attended the Annual Conference of Presidents and Secretaries at the Birmingham International Conference Centre and have reported back to Committee.

Members will be aware that in July District Judge Trevor Lamb retired. Your Committee was anxious to demonstrate the professions appreciation of Judge Lamb's long career. Mr. Peter Drake, as the Junior Vice-President, presented a gift to Judge Lamb on behalf of the Society.

Yorkshire Regional Meetings have been attended by your President and Senior Vice-President throughout the year who have reported back to Committee.

Charitable donations during the year amounted to £1,000. No political contributions were made.

#### REPORTS OF OFFICERS

#### **EDUCATION OFFICER**

The Society has now completed three full years of education courses run in conjunction with Huddersfield University. As this goes to press it is about to start the fourth year.

Support continues to be as firm as ever, perhaps reflecting the University's attempts to meet the Society's requirements that the courses should be practical and practice-orientated. It is hoped this support will continue. Members may recall that last year Huddersfield University began its legal practice course. The quality of that, assessed by the Law Society, has been up-graded during the past twelve months, reflecting the University's success in ensuring that its teaching is of real practical value. Members' support can only assist that process.

#### SOCIAL SECRETARY

After poor attendances at alternative events over the last two or three years, this year's events have been limited to the three best supported, namely the Members' Dinner, Society Trip and Annual Dinner. All of these may be looked upon as a success if numbers attending can be used as an indicator.

Members Informal Dinner — The Informal Dinner this year took us to the Design House Restaurant at Dean Clough. Thirty-two members enjoyed a first-class meal and afterwards heard from the Deputy Editor of the Law Society Gazette, Mr. Prosser.

Annual Outing — Once more the Outing has proved popular with 29 members enjoying the trip and a further member joining us for the evening meal. Coffee was taken at the Simms Road Inn (well, some members drank coffee!) after which we repaired to the Albert Dock complex in Liverpool for lunch. A further stop at the Roebuck Inn in Cheshire was made before our arrival at Belle Vue Stadium in Manchester to partake in both the evening meal and an evening of Greyhound racing.

**Annual Dinner** — The Dinner is to be held on the 17th November, again at Berties Banqueting Rooms, Elland. Again the cost of the meal has risen slightly to incorporate

an inflational rise in the cost of the meal. However, we are confident that more numbers will attend for this year's serving, due in no small part to the excellent standard enjoyed at this particular establishment.

- As mentioned above, the programme of social events this year has contracted due to poor support by members towards any events organised other than the "big three". However, I am pleased to see that numbers are up and it would appear that enthusiasm for the main stream events remains undiminished.

#### NOTES ON THE ACCOUNTS

#### 1. COMPANY LEGAL STATUS

The company is limited by guarantee of its Society members. This guarantee extends to £5 per member. There were 121 members at 31st August, 1995. Where reference is made to Governors of the Council it should be understood that they constitute directors of the company for Companies Act purposes.

#### 2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following accounting policies have been used consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the accounts. The arrangement of the income and expenditure account has been adapted to suit the special nature of the business.

#### Accounting convention:

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable accounting standards.

#### Subscriptions:

Subscriptions are included in the accounts in full in the year in which received. Provision has been made of subscriptions due but not received at the year end.

#### Fixed assets:

Tangible fixed assets are stated at a nominal value.

Due to the nature of the tangible fixed assets and the activities of the Society, the committee are of the opinion that it is not appropriate to provide for depreciation on such assets.

#### Deferred taxation:

Deferred taxation is provided on the liability method to the extent that it is probable that a liability will crystallise in the foreseeable future.
