- 1.2 As previously reported, Philip Anthony Brooks and Julie Elizabeth Willetts of Blades Insolvency Services, Charlotte House, 19B Market Place, Bingham, Nottingham, NG13 8AP were appointed Joint Supervisors of the above CVA's on 31 December 2020 under the terms of a court order following the retirement of Michael Rose as a licence-holding insolvency practitioner.
- 1.3 The CVA provides in the main for industrial disease claims from former employees and any future claims to be handled in the five-year period and, if appropriate, settled by Delta Limited, the parent Company.
- 1.4 The CVA provides for ongoing support from Marsh Limited, the claims handler, and the companies' accountant, Bostock White.
- 1.5 This report provides an update on the progress in the CVA in accordance with rule 2.41 of the Insolvency (England & Wales) Rules 2016.

- 1.6 Appendix A provides a summary of the Supervisors' receipts and payments for the period from 15 December 2017 to 14 December 2021, together with a summary of transactions for the year from 15 December 2020 to 14 December 2021 ("the period") with a comparison to the directors' statement of affairs values.

2 Progress of the CVA

- 2.7 In the period Delta Limited has contributed £411,435 in settlement of claims. In total it has contributed £806,514 during the CVA.

3 Creditors

Preferential creditors

3.1 There are no claims from preferential creditors in this arrangement.

Non-preferential creditors

- 3.2 The only unsecured creditors identified on the statement of affairs were Delta Limited and Bostock White Accountants.
- 3.3 Bostock White has confirmed that its claim for £2,310 plus VAT was settled in full by Delta Limited in January 2019.
- 3.4 Under the terms of the CVA, Delta Limited does not require settlement of its claim.
- 3.5 At the date of this report Marsh Limited is handling thirty-five ongoing claims against the twenty-three companies.

4 Supervisors' remuneration

- 4.1 Creditors approved that the basis of the Supervisor's remuneration be agreed as a set amount of £27,500. I can confirm that £5,000 was paid to the original Supervisor in the period of the report, giving total supervisors' fees to date of £17,500.
- 4.2 As previously reported, the Nominee's fee of £25,000 was settled by Delta Limited in January 2019.
- 4.3 Attached, as Appendix B, is additional information in relation to our policy on staffing, the use of sub-contractors and the expenses and disbursements of the CVA.

All the above noted insurers, except for Iron Trades, are believed to be still solvent.

Iron Trades

Iron Trades are an insolvent insurer trading as Chester Street Insurance Holdings Limited, and all claims against coverage through this company are handled through the runoff agency, Capita Insurance Services Ltd, which, as soon as the company is dissolved, will TPR (Third Party Rights) validate their policies. Once the policies are TPR validated, the Financial Services Compensation Scheme ("FSCS") will provide funding as follows:

- 100% of agreed settlement for exposures from 01 January 1972 onwards
- 90% of agreed settlement for exposures prior to 01 January 1972

Where culpable exposure took place either side of 01 January 1972, the FSCS will fund at the above levels on a pro-rata basis.

However, it should be noted that for mesothelioma claims where there is a proportion of culpable exposure from 01 January 1972 onwards, the FSCS will fund 100% of the agreed settlement irrespective of whether a proportion of the exposure is prior to 1972.
