

Borrower means LXB Property Finance Limited a company registered with company number 4712736 and having its registered office at 6 Cavendish Place, London W1G 9NB.

Banks means the banks and financial institutions listed in Schedule 1 to the Credit Agreement (shown below), their respective successors in title and any Bank Transferee (as that term is defined in clause 22.4.2 of the Credit Agreement).

Charged Assets means the Property and all other assets charged pursuant to the provisions of the security.

Facility Agent means the Royal Bank of Scotland plc and its successors in title, assignees and transferees.

Hedging Bank means a bank which is a party to a Hedging Contract and its respective successors and assigns.

Hedging Contract means, in relation to the loan, an interest rate swap agreement or confirmation or any other interest rate management agreement, in a form acceptable to the Majority Banks (as defined in the Credit Agreement), entered into or to be entered into by the Borrower with a Hedging Bank in order to hedge the Borrower's interest rate liabilities in relation to all or part of the Loan.

Loan means, at any time, the aggregate of all Advances (as defined in the Credit Agreement) outstanding at that time.

Receiver means any person or persons appointed as a receiver of the whole, or any part, of the Charged Assets.

Secured Parties means all or any of the Security Trustee, the Facility Agent, the Banks and the Hedging Bank and Secured Party shall be construed accordingly.

Security Trustee means the Royal Bank of Scotland plc and its successors in title, assignees and transferees.
