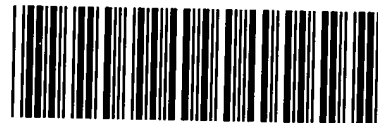

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Period ended 1 October 2016

1. Dormant status

The Company was dormant (within the meaning of Section 480 of the Companies Act 2006) throughout the period ended 1 October 2016. The Company has not traded during the period or during the preceding financial period. During these periods, the Company received no income and incurred no expenditure and therefore made neither profit nor loss.

2. Accounting policies

Company information and basis of accounting

Lambert Parker & Gaines Limited is a private company limited by shares incorporated in England and Wales. The registered office is Marston's House, Brewery Road, Wolverhampton, WV1 4JT.

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with FRS 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" ("FRS 102") and the requirements of the Companies Act 2006.

The financial statements are prepared in sterling, which is the functional currency of the Company. Monetary amounts in these financial statements are rounded to the nearest £1.

The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost convention.

These financial statements for the period ended 1 October 2016 are the first financial statements of Lambert Parker & Gaines Limited prepared in accordance with FRS 102. The date of transition to FRS 102 was 5 October 2014. The reported financial position and financial performance for the previous period are not affected by the transition to FRS 102. In accordance with the transitional exemption in paragraph 35.10(m) of FRS 102, the Company has elected to retain its accounting policies for reported assets, liabilities and equity before the date of transition to FRS 102.

The Company is a qualifying entity for the purposes of FRS 102, as Marston's PLC prepares publicly available consolidated financial statements, including the Company, which are intended to give a true and fair view of the assets, liabilities, financial position and profit or loss of the Group (note 5). The Company has therefore taken advantage of the exemptions from the following disclosure requirements in FRS 102:

- Section 4 'Statement of Financial Position' - Reconciliation of the opening and closing number of shares;
- Section 7 'Statement of Cash Flows' - Presentation of a statement of cash flows and related notes and disclosures;
- Section 11 'Basic Financial Instruments' - Measurement basis and other accounting policies for financial instruments, carrying amounts of financial instruments and information that enables users to evaluate the significance of financial instruments;
- Section 33 'Related Party Disclosures' - Compensation for key management personnel.

At the time of approving the financial statements, the Directors have a reasonable expectation that the Company has adequate resources to continue in operational existence for the foreseeable future. Thus the Directors continue to adopt the going concern basis of accounting in preparing the financial statements.
