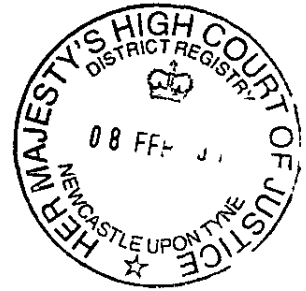

AND UPON READING the evidence

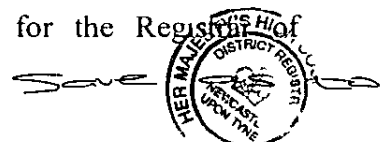
AND IT APPEARING that there is no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to

- (A) inform the Registrar of Companies of the title and Court reference number  
of the proposed litigation referred to in paragraph 3 of the Details of Claim  
enclosed in the Claim Form dated the 3 December 2010 immediately after

- (B) Inform the Registrar of Companies immediately on the conclusion of the  
proposed litigation or any appeal therefrom or the conclusion of the claim  
by any other means
- (C) Unless the proposed litigation is completed in the interim, at 6 monthly  
intervals from the date of this Order to serve on the Registrar of  
Companies a full and sufficient witness statement setting out what steps  
have been taken to progress the proposed litigation

AND UPON the solicitors for the Claimant and for the Registrar of  
Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- (1) the name of the above named Camrex Contractors (Marine) Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) If at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available, the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 00094369 Limited
- (3) an office copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (4) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"
- (5) in the event that the Claimant fails to comply with undertaking (C) above the Registrar of Companies be at liberty to commence strike off action in respect of the Company without further notice to the Claimant
- (6) The Claimant do pay to the Registrar of Companies his costs of the said Application in the agreed sum of £300 00
- (7) and this Court further orders that on the Claimant's Application, the Claimant, the said Albert William Moyse, do recover the costs of and incidental to this Application from the said Camrex Contractors (Marine) Limited in the event that his claim for damages against the said Camrex Contractors (Marine) Limited is successful
