Notes

- 'Director' includes any person who occupies the position of a director, by whatever name called, and any person in accordance with whose directions or instructions the directors of the company are accustomed to
- For an individual, his present christian name(s) and surname must be given, together with any previous Christian name(s) or surname(s).

"Christian name" includes a forename. In the case of a peer of person usually known by a title different from his surname, "surname" means that title. In the case of a corporation, its corporate name must be given.

A previous christian name or surname need not be given if:—

- (a) in the case of a married woman, it was a name by which she was known before her marriage; or
- (b) it was changed or ceased to be used at least 20 years ago, or before the person who previously used it reached the age of 18; or
- (c) in the case of a peer or a person usually known by a British title different from his surname, it was a name by which he was known before he adopted the title or succeeded to it

Where all the partners in a firm are 3 joint secretaries, only the firm's name and its principal office need be given.

Where the secretary or one of the joint secretaries is a Scottish firm, give only the firm name and its principal office.

- Lisual residential address must be given. In the case of a corporation, give the registered or principal office.
- Date of birth need only be given if the company making the return is:—

(a) a public company; (b) the subsidiary of a public company; or (c) the subsidiary of a public company registered in Northern Ireland

The names must be given of all bodies corporate incorporated in Great Britain of which the director is also a director, or has been a director at any time during the preceding five

However a present or past directorship need not be disclosed if it is, or has been, held in a body corporate which, throughout that directorship, has been:

- (a) a dormant company (whis a company which has had transactions required to be entered in the company's accounting records, except which may have arisen from taking of shares in the comby a subscriber to the memorandum as such).
- (b) a body corporate of wh company making the return wholly-owned subsidiary;
- (c) a wholly-owned subsidithe company making the re or
- (d) a wholly-owned subsidi body corporate of which th company making the return also a wholly owned subside
