AND IT IS ORDERED that an Office Copy of this Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies

AND pursuant to the above mentioned Act the said Babcock Woodall-Duckham Limited is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off

AND IT IS ORDERED that the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"

AND IT IS ORDERED that the Claimant the said Andrew Nicholson do pay to the Registrar of Companies his costs of the said Application in the agreed sum of £275-00.
