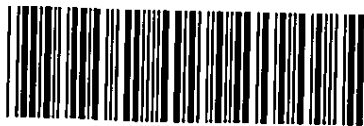


The members have not required the company to obtain an audit of its financial statements for the year ended 31st October 2006 in accordance with Section 249B(2) of the Companies Act 1985

1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2005)

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life

Land and buildings	- 2% on cost
Plant and machinery etc	- 10% on reducing balance

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date
