AND IT IS ORDERED THAT the Claimant do within 21 days from the date hereof deliver an Office Copy of this Order to the Registrar of Companies

AND FURTHER UPON application by the Claimant (and without Consent of the Registrar of Companies) IT IS ORDERED THAT the cost of these proceedings be costs in the identified pending personal injury action between the Claimant and the Company.
