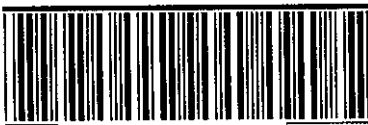

The CG was exposed to a control environment (CE) and the EG was exposed to an experimental environment (EE). The EE was designed to simulate a real-world environment with various stimuli (e.g., sound, light, vibration) and a complex task (e.g., driving a car). The subjects were exposed to the EE for a period of 10 days. The results of the experiment are shown in the table below.
