service being dispensed with

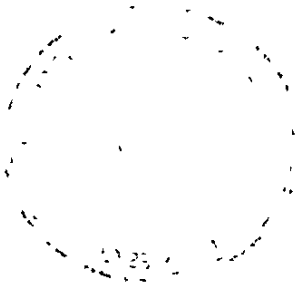
AND the Claimant by his solicitors undertaking to

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- (1) the name of the above named The Barracks Fabrics Printing Company Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the proposed name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 323589 Limited
- (3) an Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act is thereupon

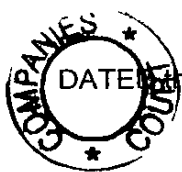
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to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had
not been struck off

(4) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his
official name in the "London Gazette"

(5) in the event that the Claimant fails to comply with undertaking (C)
above the Registrar of Companies be at liberty to commence strike
off action in respect of the Company without further notice to the
Claimant

(6) the hearing fixed for the 19 August 2011 be vacated
