#### Notes to the financial statements

### Period from 1 May 2017 to 31 December 2017

#### 1. General information

The company is a private company limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The address of the registered office is 53 Barn Road, Norwich, NR2 4PW.

#### 2. Statement of compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in compliance with Section 1A of FRS 102, 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and the Republic of Ireland'.

#### 3. Accounting policies

#### Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost basis.

The financial statements are prepared in sterling, which is the functional currency of the entity.

These financial statements cover the 8 month period from 1 May 2017 to 31 December 2017. This means that the comparative figures, which were for the year ended 30 April 2017, are not entirely comparable. The directors decided to change the reporting date of the company for commercial reasons.

#### Consolidation

The company has taken advantage of the option not to prepare consolidated financial statements contained in Section 398 of the Companies Act 2006 on the basis that the company and its subsidiary undertakings comprise a small group.

#### Revenue recognition

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable for goods supplied and services rendered, net of discounts and Value Added Tax.

Revenue from the sale of goods is recognised when the significant risks and rewards of ownership have transferred to the buyer (usually on despatch of the goods); the amount of revenue can be measured reliably; it is probable that the associated economic benefits will flow to the entity; and the costs incurred or to be incurred in respect of the transactions can be measured reliably.

#### Income tax

The taxation expense represents the aggregate amount of current and deferred tax recognised in the reporting period. Tax is recognised in profit or loss, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity. In this case, tax is recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity, respectively.

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Current tax is recognised on taxable profit for the current and past periods. Current tax is measured at the amounts of tax expected to be paid or recovered using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted at the reporting date.

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences at the reporting date. Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits. Deferred tax is measured using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the reporting date that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

#### Tangible assets

Tangible assets are initially recorded at cost, and subsequently stated at cost less any accumulated depreciation and impairment losses. Any tangible assets carried at revalued amounts are recorded at the fair value at the date of revaluation less any subsequent accumulated depreciation and subsequent accumulated impairment losses.

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An increase in the carrying amount of an asset as a result of a revaluation, is recognised in other comprehensive income and accumulated in equity, except to the extent it reverses a revaluation decrease of the same asset previously recognised in profit or loss. A decrease in the carrying amount of an asset as a result of revaluation, is recognised in other comprehensive income to the extent of any previously recognised revaluation increase accumulated in equity in respect of that asset. Where a revaluation decrease exceeds the accumulated revaluation gains accumulated in equity in respect of that asset, the excess shall be recognised in profit or loss.

#### Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost or valuation of an asset, less its residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows:

Freehold property
Plant and machinery

4% straight line

10% and 25% straight line

Motor vehicles

20% or 25% straight line 端海

Freehold land is not depreciated.

#### **Investments**

Fixed asset investments are initially recorded at cost, and subsequently stated at cost less any accumulated impairment losses.

#### Stocks

Stocks are measured at the lower of cost and estimated selling price less costs to complete and sell. Cost includes all costs of purchase, costs of conversion and other costs incurred in bringing the stock to its present location and condition.

#### Financial instruments

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as either financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deducting all of its liabilities.

#### **Defined contribution pension plans**

The company's contributions to the Group Personal Pension Policies of its employees are charged to profit and loss in the year in which they are payable.

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#### Defined benefit pension plans

The company's contributions to its employees' defined benefit pension scheme are charged to profit and loss in the year they are paid. The pension scheme members ceased to accrue future benefits in the scheme from 31 May 2004 and any further contributions relate to maintaining the solvency of the fund.

#### 4. Employee numbers

The average number of persons employed by the company during the period amounted to 43 (2017: 42).

#### 10. Pension costs - defined benefit scheme

The pension charge for the period was £25,000 (year ended 30 April 2017 - £25,000).

The most recent actuarial valuation, by the scheme's qualified actuary, at January 2015, showed that the market value of the scheme's assets was £3,553,000 and that the actuarial value of these assets represented 100% of the benefits that had accrued to members.

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The scheme is now closed to new members and no further benefits accrue after 31 May 2004. The directors are aware of the requirement of FRS 102 to obtain an annual FRS 102 valuation and to recognise the resultant asset or liability on the statement of financial position. However, they believe that the additional cost necessary to obtain this information is not commercially justified and, based upon the latest information available, they do not consider that the net effect would be material. The financial statements therefore do not comply with the recognition and disclosure requirements of FRS 102 in this respect.
