DIRECTORS AND THEIR INTERESTS

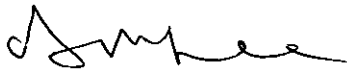
The present directors of the company, who served throughout the year, are those listed on page 2.

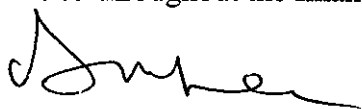
