That, subject to compliance with sections 155 to 158 of the Companies Act 1985, the giving of financial assistance by the Company to M & A N21 of 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, Durkan House, 155 East Barnet Road, New Barnet Hertfordshire, NE4 8QZ for the purpose of acquiring shares in the Company or reducing or discharging liabilities they or any other person or persons have incurred within the meaning of the Companies Act 1985 Section 152(3) and the terms and arrangements contemplated by the execution, delivery and performance by the Company of the following documents be approved:
  - a) Debenture over the assets of the Company for the benefit of Bank of Scotland
  - b) Cross Guarantee in respect of the indebtedness of M & A N21 Limited for the benefit of Bank of Scotland
