### REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- 1 The principal activity of the Society is to provide accommodation for elderly people in accordance with the aims and principles of the Abbeyfield Society Limited These activities fall wholly within the hostel housing activities as defined in the Housing Act 1974
- 2 The Society is registered under the Housing Act 1974 and as a charity It is also a member of the Independent Housing Ombudsman Scheme

### 3 RESULTS

The results for the year are set out in the Income and Expenditure Account The account shows an operating surplus of £10,449 (2011 surplus £10,661) increased to £108,195 (2011 £22,211) after allowing for interest and donations of £117,746 (2011 £11,55) A further donation of £20,000 was made to Abbeyfield Bromley to assist with the refurbishment of their property No provision has been made against income (2011 £ nil) to cover annual cyclical repairs to buildings, as no charge (2011 £ nil) was expended during the year, leaving the cyclical repairs provision unchanged at the year end and amounting to £ 60,419 (2011 £60,419)

### 4 STATEMENT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE'S RESPONSIBILITIES

The Executive Committee is required by the Companies Act 2006 to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Society at the end of the financial year and of the surplus or deficit of the Society for that period The Executive Committee considers that in preparing the financial statements the Society has used appropriate accounting policies, consistently applied and supported by reasonable and prudent judgements and estimates and confirm that all applicable accounting standards have been followed.
