The Chairman and Treasurer are elected on an annual basis and one third of the other members retire from office at the Annual General Meeting which is held in April. On the 1st April 2000 the Society appointed a paid Administrator to take on the bulk of the day-to-day business.

The Society is a local Abbeyfield Society and a member of the National Abbeyfield Society. It is a registered charity No 204444 and is a Company Limited by guarantee No 696832 established by a Memorandum of Association dated 19th June 1961.

# Objects, Organisation and Activities

The charity is established to provide housing accommodation for elderly people and the provision of food and support. The charity is organised as an independent association of local people with an Executive Committee comprising elected members. It owns the freehold of 'Wendover House' 266 Chessington Road, West Ewell, Surrey KT19 9XF and 'Grove Cottage' 10 Cheam Road, Ewell, Surrey KT17 1SN. 'Wendover House' was able to cater for eight residents in 2004 and 'Grove Cottage' for seven residents. Grove Cottage has been full for 10 months of the year and Wendover House has had one vacancy thoughout the year.

### **Finances**

The attached financial statements show the current state of the finances which the Committee consider healthy. The 2004 audited Accounts will be submitted to the Annual General Meeting for approval. The appointment of Mr Geoffrey Ross, FCA, as Auditor of the Society for the year ending December 2005 will be recommended to the Annual General Meeting for approval.
