COMPANIES ACT 2006 – SPECIAL RESOLUTION

On 8 March 2014, the following special resolution was agreed and passed by the members

That the Articles of Association of the Company be amended as follows

- 18 CHAIR
- The Council, shall receive from the Nominations Committee all candidates that meet the criteria previously set by Council for this role. Council shall then by a simple majority vote, or otherwise as it resolves, elect (in accordance with the procedures set out in the Council Rules) the Chair, who shall be a Samaritan. The Chair shall take office on the 1st October-January immediately following election or, in the event of a vacancy, on such earlier date as Council shall determine. The Chair shall chair Council meetings, general meetings of the Company and meetings of the Trustee Board.
- The term of office for the Chair shall cease on the 30th Septemberday immediately prior to the third anniversary of taking office <u>unless extended (by up to six additional months) by a majority vote of Council</u> No one person may be elected for more than two terms, consecutive or otherwise. The Chair may also be removed by Council at any time by a simple majority vote.
- 18 3 On taking office as Chair, such person if
 - (a) not already a Trustee and not having previously served as a Trustee, shall become a Trustee for the duration of the period he or she remains Chair, or
 - (b) already a Trustee, or has previously served as a Trustee, shall continue to be or shall become a Trustee again for the duration of the period he or she remains Chair, but such person shall be deemed to automatically resign as Chair on the 30th September31st December which follows or falls on the end of his or her eighth year in aggregate as a Trustee if he or she is still in office as Chair at that date
