- (1) The leasehold property known as 180 Sandgate Road and registered at the Land Registry with title number K691240 (the "Property")
- (2) The one fully paid up ordinary share of £1 in the capital of LP SD Twenty Limited;
- (3) The retail pharmacy business carried on by Lloyds Pharmacy Limited from the Property as at 12 April 2023;
- (4) The goodwill of Lloyds Pharmacy Limited in connection with the business including the exclusive right for the buyer to represent itself as carrying on the business in succession to the seller but excluding the right for the buyer to carry on business under the name.
- (5) The fixtures at the Property (excluding any which will be landlord's fixtures under any lease of the Property);
- (6) The office and dispensary equipment and all other chattels, equipment, fittings and furniture owned by the seller and used exclusively in connection with or for the business and located at the Properties save for any computer hardware or software;
- (7) Any and all (i) stock within the Property including NHS items processed but not claimed; (ii) branded and generic stock within the Properties with more than 3 months to expiry; and (iii) OTC stock within the Property (including Lloyds Pharmacy own branded products), in each case held by the seller for use in the business;
- (8) The daily record kept by the seller of the cash takings and prescription item numbers of the business and all other information held by the seller which relates exclusively to the business, including without limitation all dispensing records, the PMR and all records relating to employees (including any accident report books), but not including retained records; and
- (9) The benefit (subject to the burden) of:
 - (a) the NHS Contract; and
 - (b) any and all contracts or agreements (whether written or oral) for the sale or supply of products or services by the Business to nursing homes or residential care homes or to other customers of the business entered into by the seller in the ordinary course of the Business on or before the transfer time and which, in any such case, remain to be performed in whole or in part at the transfer time but only to the extent the entirety of such contracts or agreements relate exclusively to the business and no other retail pharmacy or business owned or run by the seller or seller's group.
