#### NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

## 1. Accounting policies

- a) The accounts have been prepared under the Historical Cost Convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective June 2002)
- b) Depreciation has been provided to write off the company's assets over their expected useful lives at the following rates:-

Fittings and Equipment 15% (reducing balance basis)

No depreciation has been provided on the freehold and leasehold buildings in accordance with FRS 15. Regular valuations are made by the directors and the buildings are maintained to a standard adequate to ensure that the market value of the properties are not less than their net book values.

- b) Turnover represents the invoiced value of goods supplied and services rendered net of value added tax.
- g) The charge for taxation takes into account taxation deferred as a result of material timing differences only between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes on a non-discounted basis.
