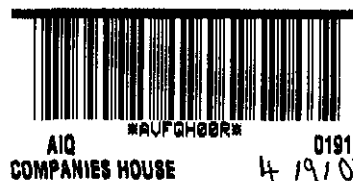
UPON THE PETITION of the above named Company by its Administrator Simon Franklin Plant presented to this Court on 6th August 2003

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the Petitioner

AND UPON READING the Administration Order dated the 23rd May 2003 (made on Petition No. 2969 of 2003) and the evidence

IT IS ORDERED

- (1) that the Administration Order be and the same is discharged
- (2) that Simon Franklin Plant be released from office as Administrator 28 days after sending to the Court and the Registrar of Companies and to each member of the creditors committee the requisite Accounts of the receipts and payments of the Company and that he be released at that date from all liabilities in respect of his acts or omissions in the administration and otherwise in relation to his



conduct as Administrator save in respect of any claim notified to the
Administrator by that date

(3) that the determination of the remuneration of the Administrator be adjourned to
the Registrar

(4) that the said Driver Construction Limited be wound up by this Court under the
provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986

(4) that Simon Franklin Plant of SF Plant & Co Lutomer House 100 Prestons Road
be appointed Liquidator of the Company

(5) that the time specified in rule 2.16(2) of the Insolvency Rules be abridged

(6) that these proceedings are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the EC
Regulation

(7) that the costs of the Petition be paid as an expense of the administration
