1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective March 2000).

The company's financial statements show that total liabilities exceed total assets at 31 December 1999. However the company's major liabilities consist of loans provided by its directors and the directors of Best Woodcraft Limited a company under the control of the same shareholders and directors. It is expected that this support will continue for the foreseeable future. On this basis the directors consider it appropriate to prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis, and therefore the accounts do not include any adjustments that would result from a withdrawal of this support.

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery etc

- 15% on reducing balance

Stocks

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items.

Deferred taxation

Provision is made at current rates for taxation deferred in respect of all material timing differences except to the extent that, in the opinion of the directors, there is reasonable probability that the liability will not arise in the foreseeable future.
