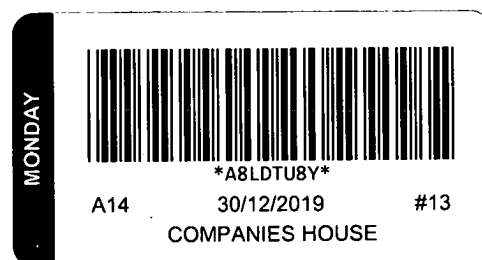

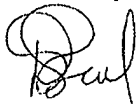

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2019

1. Basis of accounting

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102, "The Financial Reporting Standard" applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland and the Companies Act 2006.

Fixed assets

The freehold is stated at cost. The directors assess annually the need to provide for any impairments,

Depreciation

The freehold interest has not been depreciated.

Prior year adjustment

The company has no income or expenditure in its own right, all transactions in the year being related to the maintenance of the common parts in accordance with the lease. Services charges collected are held on trust for the purpose of meeting the relevant costs in relation to the property in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Landlords and Tenant Act 1987. Accordingly, the transactions and balance relating to the service charges collected from leaseholders which were included in the company's accounts for the year ended 31 March 2019 or earlier have been removed, and the prior year's figures restated. Information relating to service charges is now dealt with as a separate statement of account.

2. Tangible fixed assets

This represents the freehold reversion in the land and buildings at Whitehaugh Court, Church Road, Bishopstoke stated at cost. The leases run for 999 years from 31 January 1973.

3. Bank account

At the balance sheet date the company bank account also contained £5,949 which is held on trust under section 42 of the Landlords and Tenant Act 1987. The amount is also shown as a Creditor due within One Year.

4. Share capital

The company is limited by guarantee and has no share capital.
