1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of certain assets and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Income from investments

Investment income comprises rents received from the company's investment properties.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Fixed asset investments

In accordance with FRSSE 2008, the investment properties are revalued annually and the aggregate surplus or deficit is transferred to the revaluation reserve. Depreciation is not provided in respect of investment properties. The directors consider that this accounting policy is necessary to give a true and fair view.
