- 2. substituting therefor the following new sentence as Article 10(A):

"The minimum number of directors shall be one and there shall be no maximum number "

3. Inserting new Article 10(B) as follows.

"Where there is only a single Director, the quorum for the transaction of the business of the Directors shall be one and the sole director shall have authority to exercise all the powers and discretions by Table A and by these Articles In all other cases the quorum may be fixed by the Directors and unless so fixed shall be two. Regulation 99 of Table A shall be modified accordingly "
