
In accordance with section 288 of the Companies Act 2006, the directors of the Company propose that the following resolution be passed as a special resolution for the purposes of section 641(1) of the Companies Act 2006:


That:

1. the issued share capital of the Company be reduced from GBP 110,200,000 divided into 110,200,000 ordinary shares of GBP 1 each to GBP 80,200,000 divided into 80,200,000 ordinary shares of GBP 1 each by cancelling 30,000,000 fully paid ordinary shares (the "**Cancelled Shares**"); and
2. the sum of GBP 30,000,000 (representing GBP 1 per Cancelled Share) arising as a result of such reduction shall not be treated as a realised profit of the Company but shall instead be paid to the holders of the Cancelled Shares as a return of capital.

In accordance with section 296 of the Companies Act 2006, Julius Baer Group Ltd., being the holder of the entire issued share capital of the Company and therefore the sole member of the Company, **AGREES** to the resolution set out above.
