## **Special Resolutions**

Company name: Norfolk Historic Buildings Trust

On the 11<sup>th</sup> of December 2023 the following special resolutions were agreed and passed by the members.

- 1. THAT with immediate effect the articles of association of the Company be amended by deleting article 28 and replacing it with the following new article 28
- 28. The minimum number of directors shall be five (unless otherwise determined by ordinary resolution) and shall be subject to a maximum of fifteen.
- 2. THAT with immediate effect the articles of association of the Company be amended by deleting article 33.(3) and replacing it with the following new article 33.(3)
- 33. (3) A director must retire after a maximum of two terms of three years unless it is agreed unanimously by the remaining directors that the director should be permitted to serve further three-year terms. Directors retiring after two terms, or (with the unanimous agreement of the remaining directors) further terms, will not be eligible for re-election for a period of three years after retirement.
- 3. THAT with immediate effect the articles of association of the Company be amended by deleting article 33.(4) and Schedule 1
- 4. THAT with immediate effect the articles of association of the Company be amended by deleting article 34 and replacing it with the following new article 34

34. The chairman shall serve one five-year term unless he or she shall during that five-year term cease to hold the office of a director under article 40 or his or her appointment is revoked under the provisions of article 45(1) or he or she is not re-appointed following retirement by rotation. This article overrides article 33 (3). Ceasing to hold the office of a director shall also mean ceasing to be the chairman. If he or she resigns as chairman or his or her five-year term expires then the provisions of article 33 shall come into force again in respect of whether he or she is eligible to remain as a director. The chairman will be permitted to serve for such further number of two-year terms as may be agreed unanimously by the board.

5. THAT with immediate effect the articles of association of the Company be amended by deleting article 15.1 (a) and replacing it with the following new article 15.1 (a)

15.1 (a) Fourteen clear days for an annual general meeting or a general meeting called for the passing of a special resolution;
