- 'Director' includes any person who occupies the position of a director, by whatever name called, and any person in accordance with whose directions or instructions the directors of the company are accustomed to
- 2. For an individual, his present christian name(s) and surname must be given, together with any previous Christian name(s) or surname(s).
 - "Christian name" includes a forename. In the case of a peer or person usually known by a title different from his surname, "surname" means that title. In the case of a corporation, its corporate name must be given.

A previous christian name or surname need not be given if:-

- (a) in the case of a married woman, it was a name by which she was known before her marriage; or
- (b) it was changed or ceased to be used at least 20 years ago, or before the person who previously used it reached the age of 18; or
- (c) in the case of a peer or a person usually known by a British title different from his surname, it was a name by which he was known before he adopted the title or succeeded to it

- Where all the partners in a firm are 3 joint secretaries, only the firm's name and its principal office need be given.
 - Where the secretary or see of the joint secretaries is a Store on firm, give only the firm nan.e and .ts principal office.
- Usual residential address must be given. In the case of a corporation, give the registered or principal office.
- Date of birth need only be given if the company making the return is:-
 - (a) a public company; (b) the subsidiary of a public
 - company; or
 - (c) the subsidiary of a public company registered in Northern Ireland
- The names must be given of all bodies corporate incorporated in Great Britain of which the director is also a director, or has been a director at any time during the preceding five vears.

However a present or past directorship need not be disclosed if it is, or has been, held in a body corporate which, throughout that directorship, has been:-

- (a) a dormant company (which is a company which has had no transactions required to be ente if in the company's accounting records, except any which may have arisen from the taking of shares in the company by a subscriber to the memorandum as such).
- (b) a body corporate of which the company making the return was a wholly-owned subsidiary;
- (c) a wholly-owned subsidiary of the company making the return;
- (d) a wholly-owned subsidiary of a hody corporate of which the company making the return was also a wholly owned subsidiary.
- If the space overleaf is incufficient, the names and particulars must be entered on the prescribed continuation sheet(s).
