1 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (Effective January 2015).

Turnover

Turnover in the period represents income receivable by the company, excluding value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost less estimated residual value of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Asset class	Depreciation method and rate
Freehold ground rents	nil
Plant and machinery	10% on reducing balance
Fixtures and fittings	10% on reducing balance
Computer equipment	33% on cost

Fixed asset investments

Fixed asset investments included in the Balance Sheet are shares held for investment, and are included at cost. Gains and losses made on the investment are taken to the Profit and Loss Account as they occur.

Work in progress

Work in progress is valued on the basis of direct costs plus attributable overheads based on normal level of activity. Provision is made for any foreseeable losses where appropriate. No element of profit is included in the valuation of stock.

Financial instruments

Financial instruments are classified and accounted for, according to the substance of the contractual arrangement, as financial assets, financial liabilities or equity instruments. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the company after deducting all of its liabilities. Where shares are issued, any component that creates a financial liability of the company is presented as a liability in the balance sheet. The corresponding dividends relating to the liability component are charged as interest expense in the profit and loss account.

Pensions

The company operates a defined pension contribution scheme. Contributions are recognised in the profit and loss account in the period in which they become payable in accordance with the rules of the scheme.
