## Notes to the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2016

#### 1 Principal accounting policies

#### Basis of preparation

House of Hermanns (Growers) Limited is a Company limited by shares and incorporated and domiciled in the UK. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards and under the historical cost convention.

The Company is exempt by virtue of Section 402 of the Companies Act 2006 from the requirement to prepare group financial statements. These financial statements present information about the Company as an individual undertaking and not about its group.

These financial statements were prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 102, *The Financial Reporting Standard* applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland ("FRS 102") as issued in August 2015. The amendments to FRS 102 issued in July 2016 and effective immediately have been applied. The presentation currency of these financial statements is sterling. All amounts in the financial statements have been rounded to the nearest £.

In the transition to FRS 102 from old UK GAAP, the Company has made no measurement and recognition adjustments. FRS 102 grants certain first-time adoption exemptions from the full requirements of FRS 102. The following exemptions have been taken in these financial statements:

The Company's ultimate parent undertaking, Towers Thompson Holdings Limited includes the Company in its consolidated financial statements. The consolidated financial statements of Towers Thompson Holdings Limited are prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards as adopted by the EU and are available to the public and may be obtained from 3-5 Tower House, Amwell Street, Hoddesdon, Hertfordshire EN11 8UR. In these financial statements, the company is considered to be a qualifying entity (for the purposes of this FRS) and has applied the exemptions available under FRS 102 in respect of the following disclosures:

Reconciliation of the number of shares outstanding from the beginning to end of the period;

Cash Flow Statement and related notes; and

Key Management Personnel compensation.

As the company is a wholly owned subsidiary of Towers & Co., Limited, the company has taken advantage of the exemption to not disclose transactions or balances with entities which form part of the group.

#### Basic financial instruments

Trade and other debtors / creditors

Trade and other debtors are recognised initially at transaction price less attributable transaction costs. Trade and other creditors are recognised initially at transaction price plus attributable transaction costs. Subsequent to initial recognition they are measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method, less any impairment losses in the case of trade debtors. If the arrangement constitutes a financing transaction, for example if payment is deferred beyond normal business terms, then it is measured at the present value of future payments discounted at a market rate of instrument for a similar debt instrument.
