# Accounting Basis and Standards

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable accounting standards.

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

# Foreign Currencies

Transactions denominated in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of the transaction. Exchange differences are dealt with in the profit and loss account.
