INTRODUCTION

The Company was placed into members' voluntary liquidation on 12 December 2011 and Tim Walsh and Peter Greaves were appointed joint liquidators ("the Liquidators")

In accordance with section 94 Insolvency Act 1986, the Liquidators are required to report on the conduct and outcome of the liquidation. This report is for the period 12 December 2011 to 28 August 2012 and also serves as a progress report from 12 December 2011 to 28 August 2012 to the extent required by Section 92A Insolvency Act 1986

We are also required to provide certain information concerning the Company and the Liquidators, this information is attached as appendix A

We set out a summary of the Liquidators' receipts and payments for the liquidation as appendix B

REPORT ON THE LIQUIDATION

Realisation of assets:

The directors' Declaration of Solvency disclosed that the Company's assets comprised of the following

Following the Liquidators' appointment, the Company's inter group debt was taken under control pending distribution

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Realisations from the Company's assets are as detailed in the above summary and totalled £614,000

No additional assets have been identified. There are no assets still to be realised

Settlement of liabilities:

The directors' Declaration of Solvency and the Company's records disclosed that the Company had no liabilities.

Distributions to members:

At the time of the Liquidators' appointment, the issued share capital of the Company comprised

- 999,999 ordinary £1 shares held by AB Electronic Products Group Limited
- 1 ordinary £1 share held by TTG Nominees Limited

During the liquidation, the following distribution has been made to shareholders

 On 19 July 2012, a distribution in specie of £614,000 (representing 61 pence per share) was paid to the shareholders

The distribution in specie comprised an inter company debtor balance and any other assets held by the Company The value attributed to the in specie distribution was based on the value at which the asset was held in the Company's books

LIQUIDATORS' REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES

Basis of remuneration:

At the time of the Liquidators' appointment by the members of the Company, a resolution was passed making provision for the Liquidators to be remunerated by reference to the time properly given by them and their staff in attending to the matters arising in the winding up

Funding of the liquidation:

Although fees have been paid to the Liquidators on the basis specified above, neither the Liquidators' fees nor their expenses have been paid out of the liquidation estate. Instead, the Liquidators' remuneration and expenses in relation to the Company and 74 connected companies have been met by TT electronics plc.

Remuneration charged / expenses incurred:

The amounts shown below relate to the Company and the 74 connected companies referred to above

Our fees for undertaking this assignment consist of time costs incurred for both (i) the period up to the day of the Liquidators' appointment and (ii) the subsequent period covering the formal liquidation. Our time costs for these periods were

The above time costs for the liquidation period are calculated to 20 July 2012, being the latest practicable date. This represents 525 88 hours at an average hourly rate of £294 97

In undertaking this assignment for both the pre and post liquidation periods, £110,819 has been billed to date and final fees will be agreed and invoiced in due course. We will not recover a significant element of our time costs.
