  - (1) To carry on business as a general commercial company.
  - (2) To carry on business as makers of, producers of, distributors of, renters or hirers of, buyers and sellers of, and merchants and dealers in cinematograpgh, television and other films, videos, discs, records, tapes or other apparatus for the recording and/or reproducing of sights and sounds and all other forms of entertainment, and all rights to make, produce, distribute, exhibit or trade in any performance, entertainment or event by means of cinematograph, television and other films, videos, discs, records, tapes or other such apparatus.
  - (3) To purchase or otherwise acquire and obtain exclusive and other interests in copyrights and rights of representation and any other rights of or in plays, music, songs, cinematograph, television and other films, videos, discs, records, tapes, words, operas, libretti and compositions.

- (4) To carry on all or any of the businesses of proprietors and managers of cinemas and other places of amusement and entertainment of every kind, of film producing studios, video and sounds recording studios and radio and television studios.
- (5) To employ persons to write, compose or adapt plays, films, radio and television productions, sketches, songs, music, ballet, opera and dances.
- (6) To print, publish, or cause to be printed or published any play, film, opera, operatta, song, music or words thereof which the Company thinks fit, and to sell and distribute and deal with any matter so printed as the Company may think fit, and to grant licences or rights in respect of any property of the Company or any other person or persons, firm or company.
- (7) To carry on the businesses of music printers, copiers, publishers and booksellers.
