1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis. There is a deficit of current liabilities over current assets of £69,652 (2013:£74,334). However, the directors believe that continued financial support will be available from the creditors of the company. For this reason, the going concern basis is considered to be appropriate.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Investment properties

Investment properties are valued annually at their open market value and the aggregate surplus or deficit is transferred to a revaluation reserve.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Turnover

Turnover represents ground rents receivable.
