Liquidator's Report for the fourth year of the liquidation, from 23 September 2014 to 22 September 2015

1 Introduction

I was appointed Liquidator on the 23 September 2011 by members and creditors of the company

The company's former registered office was Countrywide House, Knights Way, Battlefield Enterprise Park, Shrewsbury, Shropshire, SY1 3AB and the company's registration number is 01821538

Please note there has been a change of practice effective from 1 January 2015 This does not affect my appointment as liquidator.

2 Realisation of Assets

Preference

Following negotiations with the former director I agreed to accept £60,000 along with the former director's undertaking to settle the amount outstanding to NatWest Bank Plc which, at the date of liquidation was £26,577 62 plus interest

The funds were received into the liquidation in May 2015 and confirmation received from NatWest Bank Plc that their debt had been satisfied in June 2015

Although the £60,000 represents only a little over 50% of the amount claimed as a preference the additional settlement of the NatWest Bank Plc liability and the agreement of all the directors, both current and former that they would not make any claim in the liquidation themselves reduced the overall creditor figure substantially resulting in a net benefit to the remaining creditors as a result

Bank Interest

The balance of funds are held in an interest bearing estate bank account

A sum of £2 60 has been received, gross of tax, for bank interest

A total amount of £89,855 43 has been realised and no further recoveries are expected to be forthcoming. A receipts and payments account is attached to this report.

3 Costs in the Liquidation

The Receipts and Payments account sets out the details of all payments made to the date of this report

An analysis of the Liquidator's costs and time spent to the date of this report is also attached

At the creditors meeting held on 23 September 2011 a resolution was passed that the Liquidator be remunerated on a time cost basis according to the time properly spent by her and her staff in their duties in relation to the liquidation, this remuneration being drawn from time to time at the Liquidator's discretion

A copy of the Liquidators time and costs is attached to this report (SIP 9) which shows that to date £34,887 50 of time costs have been incurred of which £8,790 00 was in the period covered by this report. Fees of £28,441 91 have been recovered to date leaving outstanding time costs of £6,445 59.

A description of the routine work undertaken in the liquidation to date is as follows -

- Preparing the documentation and dealing with the formalities of appointment
- · Statutory notifications and advertising
- Preparing documentation provided
- Dealing with all routine correspondence
- Maintaining physical case files and electronic case details on IPS
- Review and storage
- Case bordereau
- Case planning and administration
- · Preparing reports to members and creditors
- · Convening and holding meetings of members and creditors

2 Cashiering

- Maintaining and managing the liquidator's cashbook and bank account
- Ensuring statutory lodgements and tax lodgement obligations are met

3 <u>Creditors</u>

- Dealing with creditor correspondence and telephone conversations
- · Preparing reports to creditors
- Maintaining creditor information on IPS
- Reviewing and adjudicating on proofs of debt received from creditors

4 <u>Investigations</u>

- Review and storage of books and records
- Prepare a return pursuant to the Company Directors Disqualification Act
- Conduct investigations into suspicious transactions
- Review books and records to identify any transactions or actions a liquidator may take against a third party in order to recover funds for the benefit of creditors

5 Realisation of Assets

- · Liaising with the company's bank regarding the closure of the accounts
- Liaising with relevant parties in relation to realisation of assets, namely motor vehicles
- · Negotiating with directors regarding unlawful dividends

The choice of professionals was based on my perception of their experience and ability to perform this type of work, the complexity and nature of the assignment and the basis of our fee arrangement with them. The fees charged have been reviewed and I am satisfied that they are reasonable in the circumstances of this case.

At the meeting held 23 September 2011 it was also resolved that payment shall be made, as an expense of the liquidation, of the necessary expense of preparing the Statement of Affairs in the sum of £5,000 00 plus VAT

4 <u>Dividen</u>ds

Preferential Creditors

I have received preferential claims totalling £828 57 from the Redundancy Payments Service in relation to payments made to employees for arrears of wages and/or holiday pay

Preferential creditors have received a dividend of 100p in the £

Floating Charge Creditors

NatWest Bank Plc held a floating charge over the company's assets by virtue of the debenture granted to it by the company

A claim of £26,577 62 was received from NatWest Bank Plc on 6 September 2011 This claim was subject to interest to the date of settlement

The banks claim was settled in full including interest by the former director as part of the agreement reached in relation to the preference received by him

NatWest Bank Plc have confirmed that they no longer have a claim in the liquidation for dividend purposes

Non-Preferential Unsecured Creditors

Notice for claims to non-proving creditors was sent on 3 August 2015 with a final date for proving of 23 September 2015

After the terms of the agreement reached with the directors and former director regarding their potential claims have been applied the total unsecured creditor's claims for dividend purposes has reduced from £385,693 37 to £113,569 44

Following settlement of the outstanding liquidation costs detailed above and reserving funds for closing disbursements it is anticipated that a dividend of approximately 11p in the £ will be payable to non-preferential unsecured creditors within the next four months

5 Conclusion

The liquidation remains open at this time to admit claims for dividend purposes, calculate and pay a first and final dividend to creditors and, once all cheques have been cashed, close the bank account and prepare closing paperwork. It is anticipated that the liquidation will be closed within the next 3-6 months
