1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Progress Report summarises the progress of the liquidation for the period from 31 October 2018 to 30 October 2019 ("the Review Period").

Please note that I replaced Brendan Hogan as Liquidator of the Company by Order of the Court on 21 August 2019.

2. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this report is to detail my acts and dealing as Liquidator of Bolton Electronics Limited (In Liquidation) ("the Company") for the year ended 30 October 2019 and it should be read in conjunction with my previous correspondence to members.

Attached at **Appendix 1** is a summary of statutory information regarding the Company and the Liquidation.

3. ADMINISTRATION AND PLANNING (INCLUDING STATUTORY REPORTING)

As Liquidator, I am required to meet a considerable number of statutory and regulatory obligations. Whilst many of these tasks do not have a direct benefit, they assist in the efficient and compliant progressing of the liquidation, which ensures that I and my staff carry out our work to high professional standards.

4. ASSET REALISATIONS

My Receipts and Payment Account for the period ending 30 October 2019, is attached at **Appendix 2**. Details on asset realisations since my previous annual report are as follows:

Corporation Tax Refund

The Declaration of Solvency detailed a Corporation Tax Refund of £20,000.00. Upon my appointment discussions were entered in to with HMRC and the sum of £25,358.86 was received on 22 February 2019.

5. CREDITORS

Secured Creditor

The Company granted to Williams & Glyns Bank Plc a debenture dated 20 September 2005 giving a fixed and floating charge over the assets of the company. Although this is shown as outstanding according to Companies House, the Directors advise this was settled.

Unsecured creditors

A notice to creditors requiring them to submit claims was published in the Gazette. In addition, several letters were sent to HMRC seeking confirmation of their claims and that no tax liabilities remained.

6. DISTRIBUTIONS TO SHAREHOLDERS

No further distributions have been paid since my previous report. It is my intention to make a final distribution to members within 3 months of the date of this report.

7. COSTS AND EXPENSES

All costs and expenses incurred and paid in the review period are detailed at **Appendix 2** and summarised below.

The members authorised the fee of £2,500 for assisting the directors in placing the Company into Liquidation and with preparing the Declaration of Solvency on 31 October 2017.

Liquidators' Disbursements

The Liquidator's category 1 disbursements paid are detailed at **Appendix 2** and represent the simple reimbursement of actual out of pocket payments made on behalf of the assignment.

The Liquidator has not drawn any category 2 disbursements for the review period.

Members of the Company with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company, or any member with the permission of the court, may apply to court to challenge the amount and/or basis of the Joint Liquidators' fees and the amount of any proposed expenses or expenses already incurred on the grounds that they are excessive or inappropriate, within 8 weeks of receipt of this report.

9. CONCLUSION

The administration of the liquidation will continue in order to finalise the pension scheme requirements.
