2 Parent Company

On 01 October 2012 Kraft Foods Inc separated its North American Grocery business from its global snacking business creating two independent entities. The snacking business changed its name to Mondelēz International Inc. At 31 December 2012 the parent company and controlling party was Mondelēz International Inc, incorporated in the United States of America. This is the parent company of the smallest and largest group to consolidate these financial statements. 3 Group Accounts


