### 1) ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### 1.1 Basis of Preparation of Accounts.

The Accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and include the results of the Company's operations which are described in the Directors Report and all of which are continuing.

The Company has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No.1 from the requirement to produce a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a small company.

#### 1.2 Turnover

- Turnover comprises the invoiced value of goods and services supplied by the Company, net of Value Added Tax and of the rents received by the Company.

### . 1.3 Tangible Fixed Assets

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation.

Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

Freehold Buildings 1% straight line basis Fixtures & Fittings 25% reducing balance basis

#### 1.4 Stocks

Stocks are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving stocks.

#### 1.5 Pensions

The Company operated a defined contribution pension scheme and the pension charge represents the amounts payable by the Company to the fund in respect of the year; this scheme ceased uring the year.
