## RIDER 1

This is the Rider 1 referred to in the Form 155(6)a declared by all the directors of the Company on 10 May 2004.

Financial assistance will be provided by the Company to Mainland Holdings Limited ("Holdings") for the purpose of the acquisition (the "Acquisition") by Holdings of 1,276 "A" Ordinary Shares of the Company. The financial assistance will take the form of the execution, delivery and performance of the following documents as the same may be amended, supplemented or substituted from time to time:

- (a) a cross guarantee and indemnity made by Holdings (1) and the Company (2) in favour of the National Westminster Bank plc (the "Bank") (3) (the "Guarantee Agreement");
- (b) a facility letter to be entered into between the Company (1) and the Bank (2) and Holdings (3) in relation to an overdraft facility of up to £800,000 and a loan agreement to be entered into between the Company (1) Holdings (2) and the Bank (3) for a development loan of £360,000 (the "Facility");
- (c) an intercreditor deed to be entered into between the Company (1) Holdings (2) G
   M Couldrake & J Morris (3) B C Rogers & M C Hill (4) J J McQuade (5) R G
   Martins (6) and the Bank (7) (the "Intercreditor Deed");
- (d) a loan agreement between the Company (1) and Holdings (2) (the "Loan Agreement") under which the Company will make a loan of £1,150,000;
- (e) a loan agreement between the Bank (1) and Holdings (2) and the Company (3) under which the Bank loans Holdings £1,500,000 (the "**Holdings Loan"**).

The Company has previously granted the security detailed below to the Bank (the "Security"). By entering into the Guarantee Agreement the Company's contingent liabilities under the Security will increase and therefore the performance of the Company's obligations

under the Security will constitute financial assistance:

- (f) a mortgage debenture granted by the Company (1) in favour of the Bank (2) over all material assets dated 21 April 1989 (the "Mortgage Debenture");
- (g) a legal charge granted by the Company (1) in favour of the Bank (2) over freehold land at Site B Kettering Venture Park dated 20 June 2002 and a legal charge granted by the Company (1) in favour of the Bank (2) over freehold land at Unit D Site C Kettering Venture Park dated 1 May 2003 and a legal mortgage granted by the Company (1) in favour of the Bank (2) over Plot 46A Telford Way, dated 22 December 1989 and a legal charge granted by the Company (1) in favour of the Bank (2) over freehold land at Site C Kettering Venture Park, dated April 2004 (the "Legal Mortgages");
- (h) a chattel mortgage granted by the Company (1) in favour of the Bank (2) over items therein mentioned dated 24 June 1998 (the "Chattel Mortgage").

## RIDER 2

This is the Rider 2 referred to in the Form 155(6)a declared by the directors of the Company on 10 May 2004.

All capitalised terms in this Rider 2 shall, unless the contrary intention appears, have the meanings given to them in Rider 1.

The principal terms on which the assistance will be given are:

- under the terms of the Guarantee Agreement the Company, inter-alia, 1. guarantees to the Bank payment of all monies and liabilities of any kind whether actual or contingent which are or at any time may be due, owing or incurred from or by Holdings to the Bank, which would include (without limitation) the borrowings of Holdings from the Bank to help fund the Acquisition;
- 2. under the terms of the Facility the Bank, inter alia, makes available to the Company an overdraft facility of up to £800,000 repayable by the Company on demand and a development loan of £360,000 repayable by the Company on sales from developments made by the Company pursuant to the development loan. These sums could assist finance the loan set out at 3 below:
- 3. under the terms of the Holdings Loan the Company enters into representations and warranties and other obligations with the Bank for the purposes of assisting Holdings to borrow £1,500,000 for the purposes of the acquisition;
- 4. under the terms of the Loan Agreement the Company agrees to make a loan of £1,150,000 to Holdings for the purpose of, inter alia, funding the Acquisition and the fees and expenses incurred by Holdings, repayable in instalments and at an interest rate of 2% per annum above the bases rate of the Bank from time to time;
- 5. under the terms of the Intercreditor Deed the Company agrees to regulate the

payment by it of sums owed by it to the other parties and in particular to give priority to sums owed to the Bank (including sums owed to the Bank for the purposes of funding the Acquisition).
