- 8 3 6 Any receiver so appointed shall be the agent of the Borrower for all purposes and the Borrower shall be solely responsible for his acts or defaults and for his remuneration
- 8 3 7 Any receiver so appointed shall have all the powers conferred on mortgagees or receivers by the Law of Property act 1925 and no administrative receivers by the Insolvency Act 1986 Schedule 1 except to the extent to which those powers are expressly or impliedly excluded by the terms of this deed. In the event of ambiguity or conflict the terms of this deed will prevail
- 8 3 8 In addition any receiver so appointed shall have power at his discretion, to such extent and upon such terms as he may in his absolute discretion think fit, and notwithstanding the [administration or liquidation (or) bankruptcy, death or insanity] of the Borrower, to do or omit to do anything which the Borrower could do or omit to do in relation to all or any part of the Property In particular (but without limitation) any such receiver shall have the power
 - (a) to take possession of, collect and get in all or any part of the Property and for that purpose bring any proceedings in the name of the Borrower or otherwise,
 - (b) to manage or carry on or concur in carrying on any business of the Borrower,
 - (c) to sell (whether by public auction or private contract or otherwise), or otherwise dispose of or deal with all or any part of, the Property or of rights associated with all or any part of the Property or to concur in so doing whether in the name or on behalf of the Borrower or otherwise,

 - (g) to do (whether in the name of the Borrower or otherwise) all such other acts and things as he may consider necessary or desirable for the preservation, management, improvement or realisation of the Property or as he may consider incidental or conducive to any o the above matters or to the exercise of any of the above powers (and for these purposes the Borrower authorises the receiver to elect to waive exemption under the Value Added Tax Act 1994 Schedule 10 paragraph 2(1) on behalf of the Borrower in respect of the Property)

8 3 8 1 All money received by an receiver shall be applied by him

(a) in payment of the reasonable costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the appointment of the receiver and the exercise of all or any of his powers and of all outgoings paid by him (including preferential debts),

(b) in payment to the receiver of such remuneration as may be agreed between him and the Lender at, or at any time and from time to time after, his appointment,

(c) in or towards satisfaction of the amount owing to this security and the surplus (if any) shall be paid to the Borrower or other persons entitled to it

9 Protection of persons dealing with the Lender or a receiver

No person dealing with the Lender or any receiver appointed by him shall be concerned bound or entitled to inquire or be affected by notice as to any of the following matters

- whether any power exercised or purported to be exercised under this mortgage has arisen or become exercisable,
- the necessity or expediency of the stipulations and conditions subject to which any disposition shall be made, and the receipt of the Lender or any receiver for any money shall effectually discharge the person paying from such matters and from being concerned to see to the application or being answerable for the loss or misapplication of such money

10 Indulgency and waiver

The Lender may at any time or times without discharging or diminishing or in any way prejudicing or affecting this security or any right or remedy of the Lender under this mortgage grant to the Borrower, time or indulgency, further credit, loans or advances or enter into any arrangement or variation of rights or, either in whole or in part, release, abstain from perfecting or enforcing or neglect or fail to perfect or enforce any remedies, securities, guarantees or rights which he may now or subsequently have from or against the Borrower or any other person

- 11 2 Service shall be deemed to be affected notwithstanding the (death (or) dissolution) of the Borrower
- 11 2 1 at 10 am on the second business day immediately following the day of posting if given by first class letter post irrespective of the time or date of actual delivery or of lack of delivery,
- 11 2 2 when dispatched if given by telex or fax, and
- 11 2 3 when left at the property concerned if delivered

11 3 The methods of service described in clause 9 1 are in addition, and without prejudice, to any other method of service prescribed or permitted by law and in particular to the provisions of the Law of Property Act 1925 section 196

11 4 If the expression 'the Borrower' includes more than one person, service on any one person shall be deemed to constitute service upon all such persons

12. Validity and severability

- 12 1 Each of the provisions of this mortgage is severable and distinct from the others and if at any time one or more of such provisions is or becomes invalid, illegal or enforceable the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not be affected or impaired
- 12 2 If this mortgage is executed by or on behalf of more than one person and any one or more of those persons is not bound by its provisions (whether by reason of lack of capacity or improper execution or for any other reason), the remaining parties shall continue to be so bound as if those who are bound had not been parties to the security

13 Interpretation

- 13.1 Unless the context otherwise requires
- 13 1 1 the singular includes the plural and vice versa,
- 13 1 2 references to persons include references to firms companies or corporations and vice versa, and
- 13 1 3 references in the masculine gender include references in the feminine or neuter genders and vice versa
- Unless the context otherwise requires the expressions 'the Borrower' and 'the Lender' include their respective successors and assigns and whether immediate or derivative and where appropriate the survivors or survivor of them.
- All covenants, charges, agreements, undertakings, representations and warranties given or implied in this mortgage by more than one person shall be deemed to have been given jointly and severally by those concerned
- References to any statutory provision shall be construed as including any statutory modification or re-enactment of it and any order, regulation, directive or code of practice made under it or associated with it
- The clause headings do not form part of this mortgage and shall not be taken into account in its construction or interpretation
- 13 6 Any references to a clause or a paragraph or a schedule is to one in this mortgage so numbered or named

14. Governing law and jurisdiction

- 14.1 This mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law
- 14.2 It is irrevocably agreed for the exclusive benefit of the Lender that the courts of England are to have jurisdiction to settle any disputes which may arise out of or in connection with this mortgage and that accordingly any suit, action or proceeding arising out of or in connection with this mortgage may be brought in such courts
- Nothing in this clause shall limit the Lender's right to take proceedings against the Borrower in any other court of competent jurisdiction, nor shall the taking of

proceedings in one or more jurisdictions preclude the taking of proceedings in any other jurisdiction, whether concurrently or not

15. Limited Liability
