1. Accounting policies

Basis of preparation

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable UK accounting standards.

Statement of cash flows

The company has taken advantage of the exemption from preparing a cash flow statement provided by FRS 1 (Revised) as it is a wholly owned subsidiary within a group for which consolidated accounts are publicly available (see note 8).

Revenue Recognition

Revenue is recognised to the extent that the company obtains the right to consideration in exchange for its performance of contracted services. Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received, excluding discounts, rebates, VAT and other sales taxes or duties.

Taxation

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date where transactions or events have occurred at that date that will result in an obligation to pay more, or a right to pay less or receive more, tax, with the following exceptions:

- Provision is made for tax on gains arising from the revaluation of fixed assets, or gains on disposal of fixed assets, that have been rolled over into replacement assets, only to the extent that, at the balance sheet date, there is a binding agreement to dispose of the assets concerned. However, no provision is made where, on the basis of all available evidence at the balance sheet date, it is more likely than not that the taxable gain will be rolled over into replacement assets and charged to tax only where the replacement assets are sold.
- Deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is considered more likely than not that there will be suitable taxable profits from which the underlying timing differences can be deducted.

Deferred tax is measured on an undiscounted basis at the tax rates that are expected to apply in the periods in which timing differences reverse, based on tax rates and laws enacted or substantively enacted at the balance sheet date.

Fixed assets

The pipeline is measured at fair value less accumulated depreciation and impairment loss is recognised at the date of revaluation. Valuations are performed with sufficient frequency to ensure that the carrying amount of a revalued asset does not differ materially from its fair value. All other fixed assets are stated at cost, net of depreciation and any provision for impairment.

Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on all tangible fixed assets at rates calculated to write off the cost, less estimated residual values, over their expected useful lives on a straight line basis. The rates of depreciation are set out below:

Plant and Machinery – 4% to 10%
Office and other equipment – 20%
Pipeline – 2½%
