Form of Financial Assistance

The assistance will take the form of the execution, delivery and performance by the Company of:

- a subscription agreement between Pubmaster Finance Limited, Pubmaster Holdings Limited, Pubmaster Limited, the Company, Son of Pubmaster Limited, Daughter of Pubmaster Limited, Mercury Taverns plc, Mercury Taverns (Holdings) Limited, Deutsche Bank AG, Bankers Trust International plc and Deutsche Bank Securities Inc. relating to Class A1 Secured Floating Rate Notes due 2009, Class A2 Secured Floating Rate Notes due 2011 and Class A3 Secured Notes due 2022 (the "A Subscription Agreement"); and
- a subscription agreement between Pubmaster Finance Limited, Pubmaster Holdings Limited, Pubmaster Limited, the Company, Son of Pubmaster Limited, Daughter of Pubmaster Limited, Mercury Taverns plc, Mercury Taverns (Holdings) Limited, Deutsche Bank AG, Bankers Trust International plc and Deutsche Bank Securities Inc. relating to Class B Secured Notes due 2025 (the "B Subscription Agreement").
- an Issuer/Borrower Facility Agreement between Pubmaster Limited as Borrower, Pubmaster Limited, the Company, Daughter of Pubmaster Limited, Son of Pubmaster Limited, Mercury Taverns plc and Mercury Taverns (Holdings) Limited as Obligors, Pubmaster Finance Limited as Issuer, Bankers Trust Company as Agent Bank and Bankers Trustee Company Limited as Trustee (the "Issuer/Borrower Facility Agreement"); and
- 4. a Pubmaster Deed of Charge between, inter alia, the Obligors, the Issuer and Pubmaster Limited (the "Pubmaster Deed of Charge").

Appendix 2

The Principal Terms on which the Financial Assistance will be given

1. Following execution of the A Subscription Agreement, the B Subscription Agreement, the Pubmaster Deed of Charge and the Issuer/Borrower Facility Agreement, Pubmaster Group Limited will satisfy debt owed to HBSC pursuant to a Facilities Agreement dated 21 November 1996. The obligations of Pubmaster Group Limited had been guaranteed by the Company and its wholly owned subsidiary, Daughter of Pubmaster Limited and such security had amounted to the giving of financial assistance and had been the subject of a S155(6)(a) declaration on 21 November 1996.

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2. Following and pursuant to execution of the A Subscription Agreement, the B Subscription Agreement, the Pubmaster Deed of Charge and the Issuer/Borrower Facility Agreement, the Company and Daughter of Pubmaster Limited will grant further security and guarantee and provide indemnities in respect of certain obligations of, inter alia, Pubmaster Limited.
