#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

## 1.1 BASIS OF PREPARATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of freehold property and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

#### 12 TURNOVER

Turnover comprises revenue recognised by the company in respect of goods and services supplied, exclusive of Value Added Tax and trade discounts

### 13 TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS AND DEPRECIATION

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost or valuation less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost or valuation of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives. Freehold property has not been depreciated in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 15. It is the policy of the company to keep properties in a continuous state of repair, such that in the directors' opinion their net realiseable value at any time is in excess of their net book value in the accounts.

Motor vehicles - 25% reducing balance
Fixtures & fittings - 20% reducing balance
Office equipment - 20% reducing balance

## 1.4 REVALUATION OF TANGIBLE FIXED ASSETS

As permitted by the transitional provisions of the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008) the company has elected not to adopt a policy of revaluation of tangible fixed assets. The company will retain the book value of land and buildings, previously revalued at 30 April 2005 and will not update that valuation.

### 1.5 INVESTMENTS

Investments held as fixed assets are shown at cost less provision for impairment

### 1.6 PENSIONS

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme and the pension charge represents the amounts payable by the company to the fund in respect of the year
