- (3) the Claimant do serve a copy of the Order on the Company's former liquidator within 21 days of the date hereof
- (4) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 02606710 Limited
- (5) an Office Copy of this Order be delivered to the Registrar of
 Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the
 company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in
 existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (6) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in her official name in the "London Gazette"
- (7) the Claimant do pay to the Registrar of Companies her costs of the said Application in the agreed sum of £300.00
