#### Structure, Governance and Management

Island Concerts Limited is a registered charity number 1019518

The sole director is R Milner Esq who is responsible for the direction and management of the charity

#### **Objectives and Activities**

The principal activities are to promote, improve, develop and maintain public education in and appreciation of music by the organisation of public concerts, mainly on the Isle of Wight, by professional orchestras and musicians

## Achievements, Performance and Financial Review

This report covers the fourth year of trading as a registered charity from 1<sup>st</sup> February 2007 to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2008. During this period a recital was staged with Richard Studt and friends on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2007 at St Catherine's Church to a full house by our associates in Ventnor involving marketing assistance from Island Concerts Ltd

For the first time a concert was staged by the Royal British Legion Central Band under the direction of Captain David Cole at the Cowes Yacht Haven Events Centre on the occasion of the Rotary Club of Cowes St George's weekend on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2007 The Shipshod singers from Yarmouth also took part

On Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2007, a recital was held at the Royal Yacht Squadron's Pavilion by the pianist Eva Maria Doroszkowska commemorating the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the only dedicated air raid on Cowes on 4<sup>th</sup> May 1942. The proceeds from this concert were split with the Blyskawica Society to support the museum ship that is berthed in Gydinia, Poland. Eva is the granddaughter of the then captain of this Polish naval frigate which added significance to the occasion. The other concert associated with the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebrations was held at St Mary's Church, Cowes by the Ave Verum Choir with modest marketing support from Island Concerts.

Our core support, however, continues for The Sinfonietta at our regular venue of All Saints Church in Ryde and two concerts were staged there on the 2<sup>nd</sup> October and the 14<sup>th</sup> December 2007 performing all six of the Bach Brandenburg Concertos over the two concerts

Thanks again go to our supporting sponsors, the Isle of Wight County Press, Crossprint, Wightlink Ferries, the Isle of Wight Council and the Isle of Wight Music Fund enthusiastically run by Joyce Partridge. In addition this year, the Daisie Rich Trust provided valuable assistance in the form of a grant But it is our patrons who provide the major support enabling these concerts, directed by Richard Studt and the players of the former Bournemouth Sinfonietta, to continue on a manageable financial basis
