8. Any other business.

Steve Benn - Had a text from Peter Stonehouse who could not attend the AGM. He proposed a joint event for next year (2020) with the MV and Laverda clubs. **RD** is aware of the idea but further planning would need to be carried out and will be in contact with the other clubs.

Steve Gooch - MCN show, SG would like someone else to take over for next year (2020). He will carry on organising the Copdock Show DOC GB participation.

Martyn Edwards - World Superbike Championship Donington Park, it is currently planned that entry will be free each day for members who arrive on a Ducati and present their DOCGB membership cards at an assigned entry gate There will be a marquee set up at Redgate to celebrate 25 years of the 916. Further details for entry and the display stand will follow.

Mark Coupe - Asked why the club had £27.5K in the bank. ME explained we are not saving up for anything but we need a buffer in case something financially goes wrong. There is no specific amount held as a buffer. RD suggested that £20K was a reasonable figure. The general consensus being that this was about the right level.

Peter Ward - Asked about the current rules on life members. **ME** informed the meeting that we no longer have a rule in the Articles of Association for life memberships and that they are not a viable option for the club.

Kevin Baker - In the process of setting up a 'for sale' section on the website, this will be members only. This will run in conjunction with DESMO magazine. Giving members the opportunity to advertise items

Tim Mallion - Asked about having a survey being on the website to ask members what they want from the club as there was so few attendees at the AGM for 1854 members. **RD** informed the meeting that this has been done recently and the results were made available. A summary of the survey was published.
